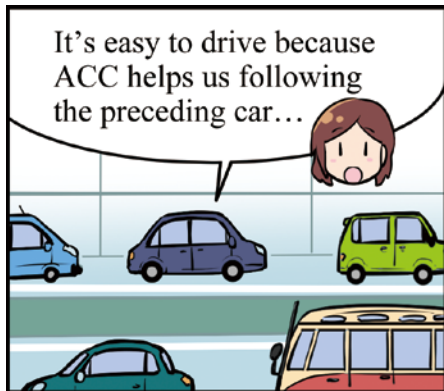
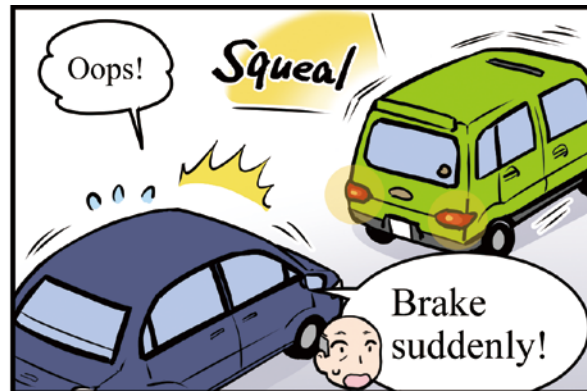


On an expressway

You put on the brakes too frequently because you are hard to gauge the distance in front of you.



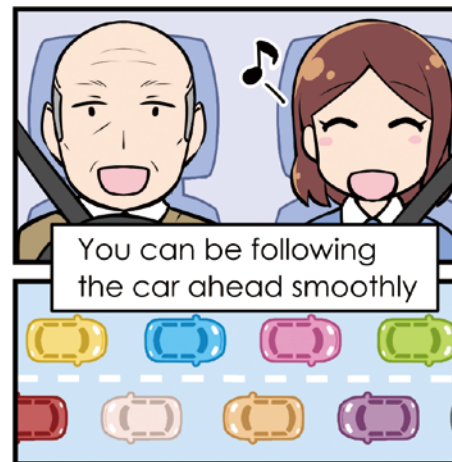
ACC: Adaptive Cruise Control: driving at a fixed speed, controlling the distance between the car ahead



You can stay the optimal distance from the car ahead, with the CACC.



CACC: Cooperative Adaptive Cruise Control: Adjustment of the distance between cars using information provided by the preceding car
